

Access legislation in one click

Use the search field with dynamic lookup list on the home page to access the legislation you need *fast*.

Access legislation in one click

To search from the home page using search terms: ① Type the jurisdiction (optional) followed by your search terms into the search field. A dynamic lookup list featuring the top results will appear. ② Click on a title to go straight to the full text legislation. ② If you cannot see the title you need, click the search LawOne option to load the full list of search results. ① For best results, use search operators (such as double quotation marks for an exact phrase). →








To search from the home page using act number and/or year: ① Type the jurisdiction (optional) followed by the act number and/or year. A dynamic lookup list will appear featuring the top results. ② Click on a title to go straight to the full text legislation. ② If you cannot see the title you need, click the search LawOne option to load the full list of search results. ① You can also search for a title using an FRLI number. →











Access legislation via quick search

Conduct a Google-style search on the home page, then refine and sort your search results to find a legislative title quickly.

Access legislation via quick search

On the home page: ① Type your search terms into the search field. These can include the jurisdiction, year, act number, title keywords and FRLI number. ② Hit enter or click on the search icon to load the search results. ① For best results, type the jurisdiction followed by the act number or year before the title keywords, and use search operators (such as double quotation marks for an exact phrase). →






Access legislation via quick search continued

On the search results page, you can: ① Narrow your results by jurisdiction, principal, document, status, subject and responsible department (where applicable) in the sidebar. ② Sort your results. ③ View more results (if available). ④ Click on the key info icon to view core info and quick links. ⑤ Click refine search to open the search panel and access more search options. ⑥ Save your search. ⑦ Click on a title to view the full text or details. →




Access legislation via quick search continued

Using the key info panel, you can access (where applicable): ① The full text. ② A link to the original source. ③ Currency and assent information. ④ Quick links to bills, downloads, tables, responsible government departments, related instruments (including cases and subordinate legislation) and relevant subjects. ① To load all key info on a new page, click view all details. →




To further refine your search results: \bigcirc Click on refine search. The search panel will open. \rightarrow



Access legislation via quick search continued

Using the search panel, you can: ① Modify your search terms in the search field. ② Select a jurisdiction. ③ Restrict your search terms to titles, all headings (including subheadings) or section headings within a document. ④ Click search to update your results. ① All search configurations are saved for the duration of your session. →





Popular search operators

TIMEBASE LAWONE QUICK START GUIDE

Find	Operator (not case sensitive)	Example	Explanation
This term	Use the term of interest	writ	Finds sections containing the term writ.
This exact phrase	u n 	"assessable income"	Finds sections containing the exact phrase assessable income.
Any of these terms	OR, or, ,	misleading OR deceptive	Finds sections containing ANY of the terms misleading, or deceptive, or both.
All these terms	AND, and, &, space between words	employee AND entitlements	Finds sections containing BOTH terms employee and entitlements.
Not excludes unwanted terms	NOT, not, !	custody NOT child	Finds sections containing the term <i>custody</i> that DO NOT include the term <i>child</i> .
Match a single character	?	licen?e	Finds sections containing the terms <i>licence</i> and <i>license</i> .
Match multiple characters	*	neglig*	Finds sections containing variations of the term that starts with <i>neglig</i> such as <i>negligent</i> , <i>negligence</i> , <i>negligently</i> , <i>negligible</i> .
Terms within n characters	/n	breach /20 contract	Finds sections containing the term <i>breach</i> within 20 characters of the term <i>contract</i> .

Key points to remember

- ► Search terms can include **jurisdiction** (CTH, NSW), **year, act number, title** keywords and **FRLI** number.
- ▶ For best results, type the **jurisdiction** followed by the **act number** and/or **year** before the title.
- ▶ Use **search operators** (such as double quotation marks for an exact phrase).
- ▶ Use the **key info icon** to access core information and quick links.
- ▶ Look for **help icons** to access useful tips and instructions.
