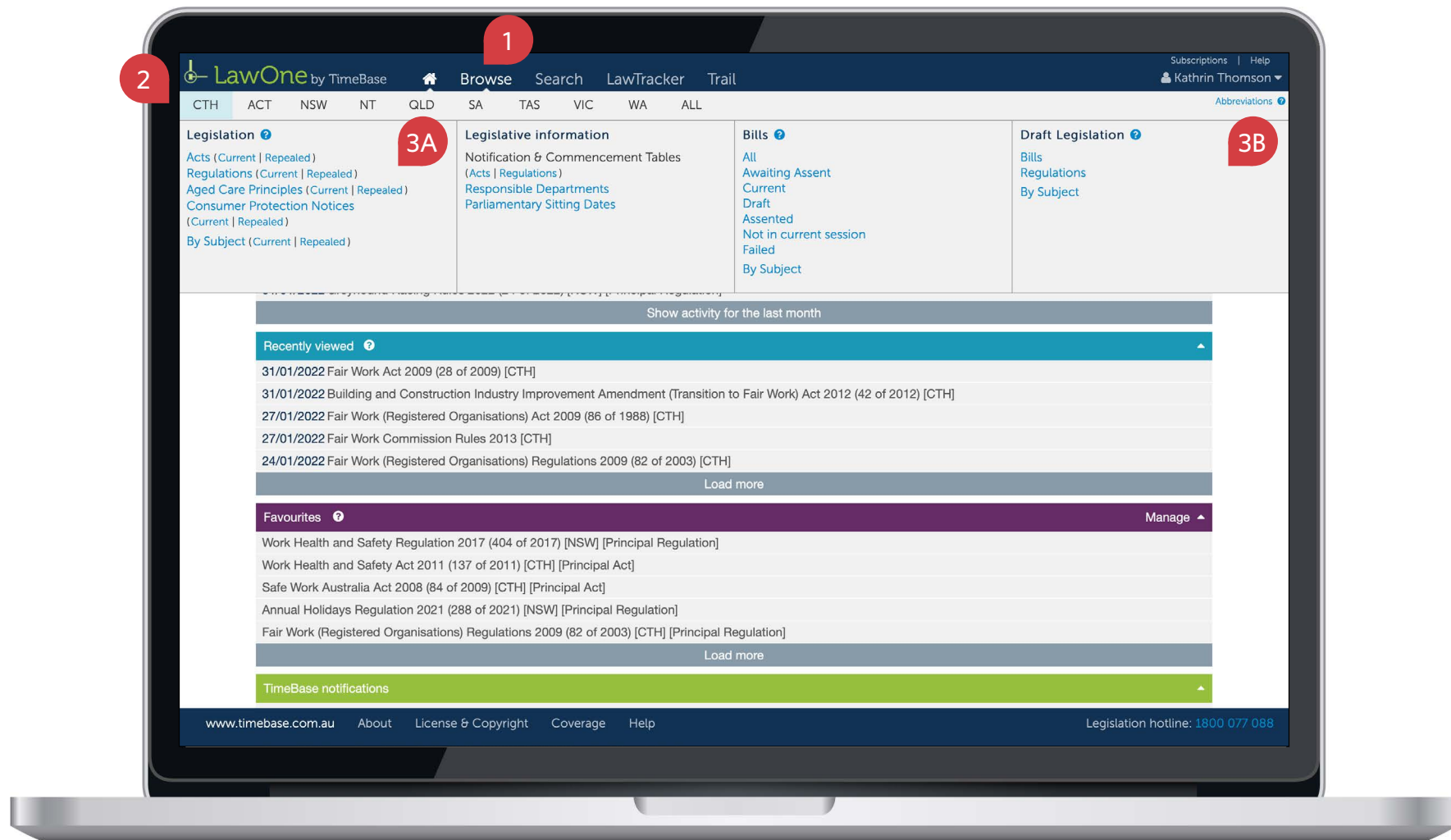
### Browse legislation and bills

Use the browse panel to browse acts, regulations, aged care principals, consumer protection notices, bills and draft legislation by currency, status and subject.



## Browse legislation and bills

**From any page:** ❶ Click on **browse** to open the browse panel. ❷ Select a jurisdiction (including all). ❸ Click on an option in the — ❸A **Legislation** menu OR ❸B **Draft legislation** menu. The **browse results page** will load. ⚠ If you opt to browse **by subject**, the browse results page will load with the subject sidebar and filters expanded. →

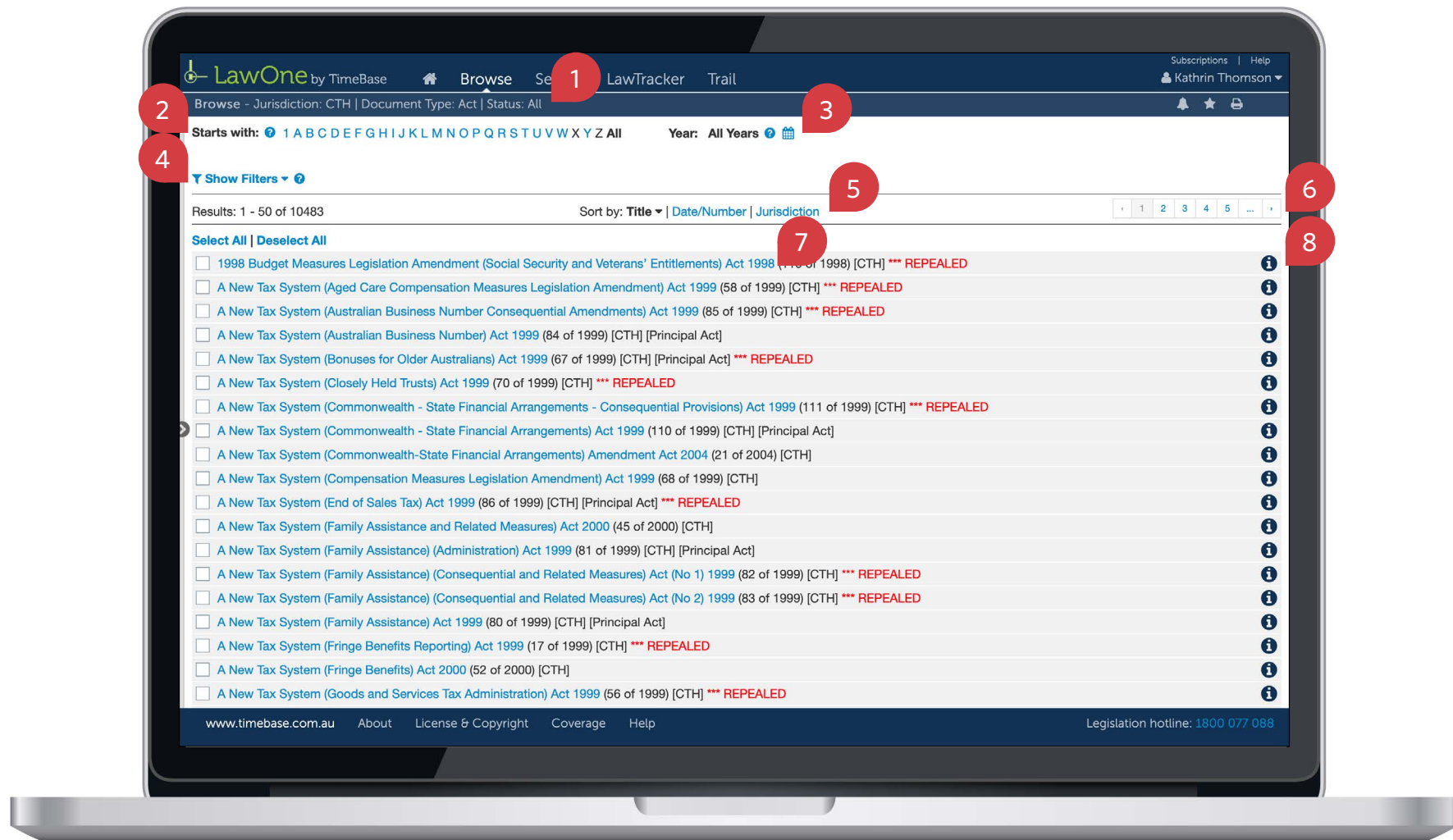

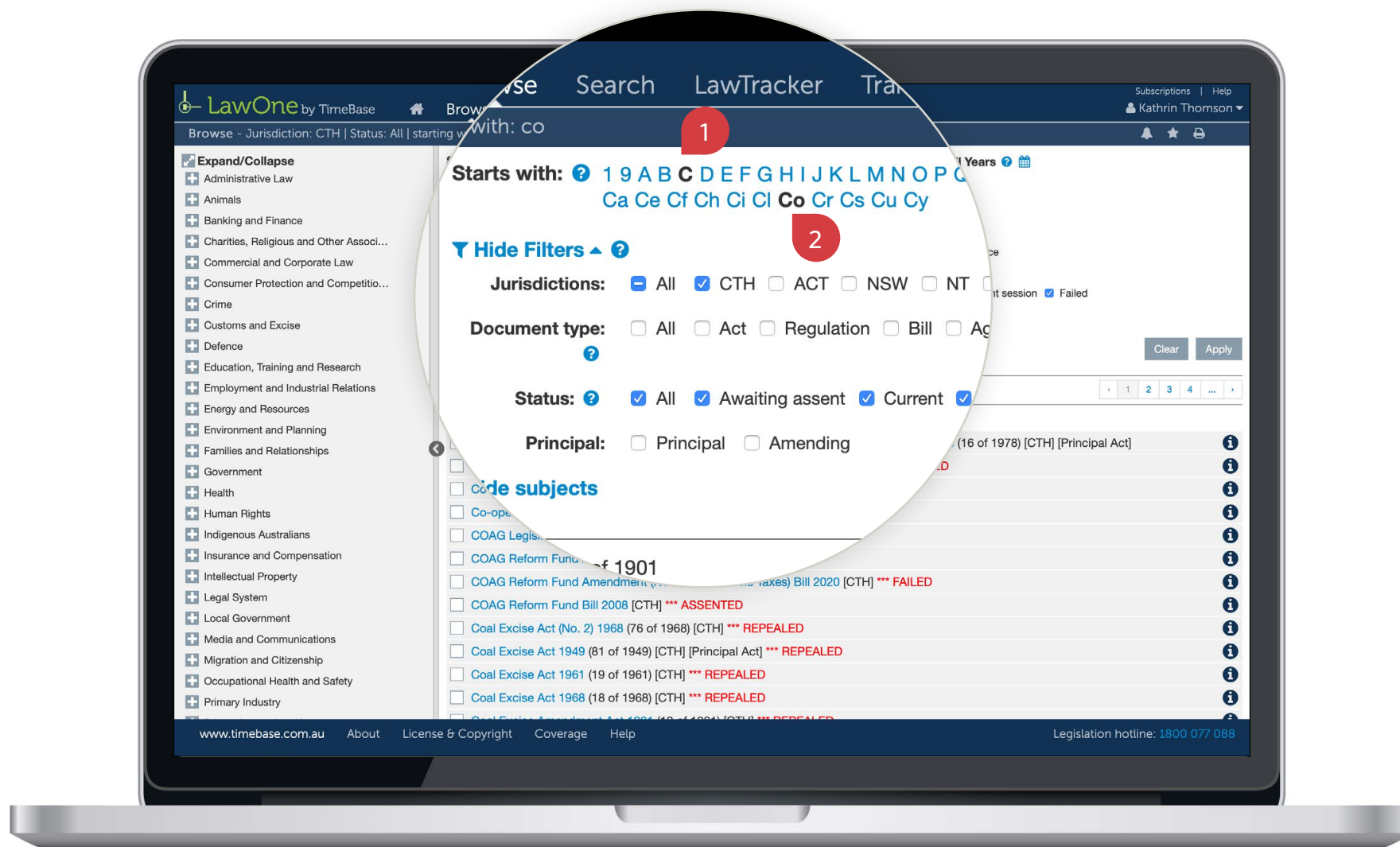
